

## Teacher Lesson 2: Let's Look at Tuff-Bot's Buttons

Tuff-Bot has many buttons. They are easy to use. Let's see what they are all about.

Find the **Power** button and turn it on. Watch what happens.

Look for the **Control** buttons that move and turn Tuff-Bot.

Find the button to turn **Sound** on and off.

Find the **Speed** button. We'll learn more about that soon.

Find the **Avoidance** button. We'll learn about that later, too.

The Avoidance sensors are in the headlights. Can you find the **Light Sensor**? (it's a small hole)

The sound comes from the speaker, an array of small holes near the back of Tuff-Bot.



The Control buttons let you move Tuff-Bot forward and back, turn it left and right, erase its commands, pause it, and start it. Can you guess which button does what by looking at them?

Next, we'll try them all!



### Note:

In Student Activity 2, if you have just one Tuff-Bot, have groups of 3 or 4 students at a time try this activity. If you have enough Tuff-Bots, then all students can participate in small groups at the same time.
