

Student Activity 9: Use the Tuff-Bot Online Emulator

The Tuff-Bot Online Emulator lets you play with virtual Tuff-Bot. Virtual means that it is on your computer, not in your classroom. The emulator imitates how Tuff-Bot works. In the emulator, you control Tuff-Bot by clicking the buttons on a picture of Tuff-Bot on the screen.

When your teacher tells you to, go to <u>tuffbot.terrapinlogo.com/?rocks1</u>.

You will see Tuff-Bot on a dirt background. You can add some rocks to the scene. In the drop-down menu called "Number of rocks", choose a number from 0 (None) to 10. The rocks will appear! If you don't like the random way they are positioned, you can reload the window, or choose a different number of rocks, and then choose the number you original wanted. They will appear in different places.





The emulator version works just like the Tuff-Bot. You can even see the list of commands you have entered.

Can you navigate Tuff-Bot around the rocks? Turn on Obstacle Avoidance and have some fun!

Try some of the other online mats at <u>tuffbot.terrapinlogo.com</u>. Obstacle Avoidance only works with the Rocks mat because the rocks are specially designed with work with the Avoidance feature.
